




flawlessly, regularly remove any impurities. For additional safety, we recommend wearing gloves.


The blade automatically retracts into the handle the moment cutting ceases. Even when blades. the slider is still **being held forwards**.




When cutting film, be sure there is **enough counter-pressure** that the blade does not retract by itself.



For best results, cut plastic strapping band diagonally (at a 45° angle).




Now either rotate or change the blade, before pulling the blade carrier back into its original position.



Finally, fold the **upper half of the handle back down** until it snaps into place. Please check blade retraction!
